    - i. Orientation to the ping-pong swimlane that was in the 2B Detailed Design and the updated Governance proposal

    - iii. Today will be focusing on the first orange ball and line: how does an idea because a concept
  - b. Workplan development
    - i. Overview of process
    - ii. Confirming understanding that if things do not make it onto workplan, it stays in holding pattern for PRC
      - 1. Suggestion to include summary of items not included in workplan and suggestions for which should stay in holding and which should be removed from list
      - 2. Suggestion that in prioritization step, we should consider merging concepts that are similar if appropriate. Will need to consider how this works with sponsor concept
  - c. Zoom in to how a concept is received
    - i. Review of comparison between SPP and CAISO process
    - ii. Discussion of preference to have more detail and solutions provided that CAISO, but do not want a barrier to entry
