#### **Key Discussion Points**

- Energy Deployment in Market vs. Bilateral
  - Bilateral exceptions: non-market WRAP Participants should be able to transact Energy Deployments bilaterally if they want, WRAP remains agnostic
- Settlement Pricing for Non-Market Cases
  - Capacity payments are a sufficient component of settlement for Energy Deployments optimized through the markets, but non-market Participants transacting outside of markets will require an index.
  - Market Participants within an MBOS should rely on the market to determine energy price.
  - The "adder" concept was originally meant to ensure markets are used before turning to WRAP. The adder should be removed.
  - Some hesitation remains about handling mixed subregions with both market and non-market participants.
