1. Review Draft Concept Paper

- a. <u>Timing and restudy questions</u>
 - Five restudy options considered:
 - 1. Don't restudy; keep PRM unchanged
 - 2. Restudy; use new PRM
 - 3. Restudy; use new PRM with bounds from prior PRM
 - 4. Restudy for information only; PRM unchanged

• <u>Discussion points:</u>

- Restudy effort depends on timing and participant exits; compute time may be significant.
- o General preference not to change PRMs once adopted by the Board, or at least not to increase them.

- o Group decided: No change to PRMs, potential for advisory if exit threshold met
- o Agreement to flag this in the paper as an item needing deeper consideration.

b. Methodology

- Options reviewed: Seasonal LOLE vs. Peak Month LOLE + shoulders.
- Interest in revisiting inclusion of March and will mention so in the concept paper.
- Noted possibility of "mix and match" methodology (and make note of that in the paper).
- ELCC discussion considered out of scope for this paper but may be revisited; placeholder could be added.

Summary:

- Members to send additional comments on the draft to Maya by end of day 8/27.
- Paper will be updated to reflect:
 - o Agreement on PRM stability (not changing after Board adoption).
 - o Methodology discussion with flexibility for hybrid approaches.
 - o Notation to revisit March and to placeholder ELCC for future discussion.

- a. Action WPP and Co-chairs update concept paper and develop final draft
- b. Meeting September 3rd: finalize concept paper for RAPC
- c. Action WPP does any final clean-up and sends concept paper to RAPC September 4th
