
#### **OBJECTIVE**








# PARTICIPATION PER FILE TYPE








## FILE PUNCTUALITY

#### FILE PUNCTUALITY AND SUCCESSFUL UPLOADS

- These charts show the percent of successfully submitted files that were uploaded late or on time
  - There were approximately 57,000 files attempted to be uploaded
    - There were 56,540 files submitted successfully this season




#### **File Upload Success Rate**





#### **2024 Summer File Upload Punctuality**






### DEFICITS & SURPLUS

#### **DEFICIT AND SURPLUS INTERVALS**

- The following chart counts the number of times a participant was either surplus or deficit for a given hour
  - For example, if 20 participants are surplus for a given hour on a day, then this would increase the count by 20
- There were deficit intervals throughout the season but most of the occurrences showed up during July and August
- The surplus intervals were fairly consistent throughout the season






### FILE UPLOADS

#### PERCENT OF EXPECTED FILES UPLOADED

- Measures the percent of files that were uploaded versus how much were expected
  - PSD Amounts
    - MD,VH,PL,PTPL: 1
  - Daily Amounts
    - OD: 24
- Only counted files that were uploaded successfully
- The cases with Participants uploading more than the required number of files for a day, we capped these submittals at the expected upload values
