

Regional Transmission Planning in the West

Growing Recognition more Transmission is Needed



Current Approach to Planning Insufficient

- »<u>No</u> Regional Transmission Projects have been built
- » Forward looking planning limited
- » Interregional Planning has been virtually <u>nonexistent</u>

»Engaging with the region to explore a new approach for West-wide transmission planning that will result in an actionable transmission plan to address regional and inter-regional needs.




Differences from FERC 1000 Planning






